

## PAPER PREPARATION GUIDELINES

**Authors are strongly advised to follow the guidelines for the preparation of papers. Papers that do not meet formatting requirements will be returned to the author for revision or rejected.**

Length of the paper is 5 (five) full pages size A4, including figures and tables.

The preferred format is MS Office Word for Windows (\*.doc).

**Margins should be set to:** left – 28 mm, right – 28 mm, top – 28 mm и bottom – 35 mm.

Full names of the authors (Country)

Name of the University, city

*(lowercase letters, Times New Roman, 14 pt.. align to the right edge)*

Scientific advisor: Name, title and scientific degree of a scientific advisor

*(lowercase letters, Times New Roman, 12 pt.. align to the right edge)*

### **TITLE OF THE PAPER**

*(The title of the paper should use Times New Roman 14 point font, bold, uppercase letters and be centered on the page)*

Use Times New Roman 14 pt, 1 spaced, no hyphenation, justified. Indented 1.00 cm from the left margin

Formulas are typed in MathType or Equation Editor with default settings. Formulas referenced in the paper should be numbered.

Table captions should use Times New Roman, 13 pt, italic.

Figures are of raster format, JPEG or TIFF, 300 dpi resolution, black and white.

Figure captions should use Times New Roman, 12 pt, italic.

Citations should be numbered consequently in square brackets [1]. Use GOST 7.1-2003 for references.

Paper file must be named using the surname and name of the author.

Ex. Paper – **Ivanov.doc**; Figure – **Ivanov-fig1.jpg**; Table – **Ivanov-tab1.doc**.
